## Treasurers Report

## Presidents Report

TA shared slides of winter flowering plants including daphne, bergenia and hellebores. Recommending the Post Office Farm Nursery for hellebores. Old hellebore leaves should be cut away now to let the flowers shine. TA has planted beautiful Galanthus which should spread in the garden over time.

Club will be subsidising the cost of the coach for the outing in September. Last year our Christmas Party was subsidised by \$4k. The funds come from propagating and selling plants at the Trade Table and the Garden Ramble Stall. Ted asked members to propagate as much as they can.

### **Potting Shed**

TA interviewed Sue Sutton, owner of Mt Murray Nursery who brought a selection of bare rooted roses for members to purchase. Bare rooted roses are cheaper than potted as a lot less cost to transport. Also save on packaging.

To plant: Trim roots if necessary, dig a hole a little deeper and twice as wide. Fill hole with water and 50/50 mix of soil and compost. Water once a week to establish roots. Feed early spring, early summer, early autumn.
